

SJW Vermont Ride: Calvin Coolidge Homestead – Plymouth Vt.

- start (Inn parking lot) - set 0.0 mileage at cars
- 0.0 L Leave the Inn onto Rt 4 East. Mostly downhill - quite steep at times - watch your speed.
- 7.7 S We meet at the First Stop Bike Shop at West Bridgewater Corner. We will leave cars there as needed. Continue straight on Rt 4.
- 13.4 R Bridgewater Corner, Rt 100A South
- 17.7 S Coolidge State Forest is on your left. A possible side trip.
- 19.1 R Off Rt 100A, up small hill to the old Town of Plymouth.
- 19.2 * The old Town of Plymouth is where President Coolidge was born on July 4, 1872. We get a good rest here, visiting various well preserved buildings including the Cheese Factory.
- 19.3 R Leave by the South entrance, then right on Route 100A.
- 19.4 S Hysteria Hill: Watch your speed. Stop Sign very soon at the bottom.
- 19.6 L Rt 100. Pleasant ride about 4 miles passing small lakes to Echo Lake.
- 23.5 R Stop at Echo Lake Inn - rest - go back north on Route 100.
- 31.7 S Nice spot for a rest - put your feet in the cool water - at the Woodland Reservoir boat landing.
- 32.0 L We have returned to West Bridgewater Corner. Decision time - bike the mountain or ride the Sag.
- 41.6 R Back at the Inn - some by Sag, some by Will Power.
